# II. INLOGOS' Support to Policy Intervention

- INLOGOS working with UNICEF supported GoN to develop a National Strategy on Child Friendly Local Governance (CFLG). The strategy was endorsed by GoN and replicated nationwide
- Now the LGOA included this strategy as one of the major duties of LG to declare them child friendly. This initiative gives an opportunity to internalize the Child Rights issues within the government mechanisms
- We supported MoFAGA and MoHA in developing five different guidelines on DRRM. The guidelines have been owned by the government which is under implementation.
- INLOGOS provided support to the LGs on revenue analysis and assessment, social accountability and different spheres of fiscal and political governance.
- Recently INLOGOS supported Lalitpur Metropolitan City to develop a Regulations (2023) to regularize the municipal financial procedures.

# 12. Support for Earthquake Victims

- The devastating earthquake of April-May 2015 in Nepal has rendered many people homeless, jobless and foodless. Thousands have lost their lives and left their families in grief and intense fear. Many children have become orphan and many children deprived from food, health care, and education services and proper guardianship. The immediate rehabilitation of the affected people and restoration of the damaged houses and structures in the affected area was a huge task and required much time and cost as well.
- INLOGOS could not remain indifferent to the great challenges facing the country, hence came
  forward to support Gairibisauna Deupur VDC (now merged with Mandon Deupur Urban
  Municipality) in Kavre district. INLOGOS provided immediate relief and rehab services to the 67
  deprived families, renovated one school building and maintained a drinking water project there.
